The Silicon Valley Boychoir, founded in 2010 and based in Palo Alto, is searching for a part-time instructor to teach musicianship classes two afternoons a week (Monday and Tuesday) and oversee music theory homework. The 15-20 minute classes include sight-reading and ear-training. A flexible curriculum is provided.

Responsibilities include:

- · Teaching short classes during the rehearsals for beginning and intermediate boys
- · Correcting music theory homework and updating student progress.
- Communicating with directors to integrate skill building with music learning.
- · Communicate with parents and provide input for semester-end evaluations.

Applicants should have:

- Familiarity with Curwen hand signs and teaching sight-singing using movable do
- A choral and/or voice background
- A good understanding of elementary and intermediate music theory
- Experience working with children
- Piano skills are a plus
